What is the Level 2 Award in Letting and Managing Residential Property?

The Level 2 Award in Letting & Managing Residential Property is a qualification suitable for residential private



landlords, letting/managing agents and housing association staff letting and managing market-rented housing. The programme has been developed in partnership with the Residential Landlords Association and provides the skills and knowledge to enable landlords and agents working in the market-rented sector to perform their role at a high standard.

The qualification consists of three units:

- · Tenancies and the law
- Property and tenancy management
- Customer care in the private-rented sector

The learning outcomes for each unit are listed overleaf.

Who can apply to study this qualification?

- Individual landlords, letting one or a small portfolio of residential properties
- Letting and managing agents
- Housing association staff letting and/or managing market-rented properties
- Housing advice workers
- People not currently working in housing but considering a frontline housing position as a career option

What are the learning outcomes?

Tenancies and the law

On completion of this unit, students will:

- 1. Understand the different types of tenancies in the private rented sctor
- 2. Know the legislation relating to private tenancies
- 3. Know about other legal requirements pertaining to property condition of homes that are let.

Property and tenancy management

On completion of this unit, students will:

- 1. Know how to create and renew a tenancy
- 2. Know how to end a tenancy
- 3. Know the financial aspects of letting a home
- 4. Know how to maintain the property.

Customer care in the private rented sector

On completion of this unit, students will:

- 1. Know the key trends in the rental market
- 2. Understand the principles of equality and diversity
- 3. Understand how to deal with complaints and disputes
- 4. Know the principles of customer care.
