



Fire Safety Awareness and Risk Recognition for Housing Professionals

We're pleased to announce the launch of the above training course which has been developed by CIH Scotland and Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (SFRS) to provide housing professionals working in a community setting the ability to identify households and tenants that are most at risk from fire. This course will also teach attendees how to refer tenants to SFRS for a Home Fire Safety Visit and work more closely with SFRS to help tenants at risk.

This course is based on the extensive knowledge and experience SFRS have acquired attending and dealing with accidental dwelling fires and the preventative measures that can be implemented.

This training is applicable to all staff who regularly visit and assess people within their own home. However, on a more general level this course is of benefit to all employees as it provides a basic awareness of fire safety that can be applied to all domestic situations.

There will also be an opportunity to download an e-learning module and app following the course.
