- Know who has a right to reside
- Know the main factors that are relevant in establishing habitual residence
- Understand residence rights for workers, self-employed people and people with retained worker status
- Understand who can derive residence rights as a family member
- Know when someone has a permanent right of residency
- Understand the additional restrictions which affect Croatian nationals
- Be aware of recent developments in legislation and how European nationals are affected
