Fixed term tenancies

This course will benefit those who require a greater understanding of the implications of fixed term tenancies and how best to implement them.

Why should I attend?

During this course delegates will :

- Look at flexible tenancies – a new form of tenancy introduced by the Localism Act 2011 which can be used by local authorities. A time-limited form of secure tenancy that carries many of the same rights as a secure tenancy
- Look at assured shorthold tenancies, granted for fixed term – a form of tenancy granted by housing associations where they wish to let a property for a fixed period of time
- Consider the benefits that are expected
- Consider the relationship between affordable rent and fixed term tenancies
- Look at potential benefits from the use of fixed term tenancies

How is the course delivered?

Our courses run from 09:45 – 16:30. Delivered by expert trainers they bring together formal training with day-to-day experience. Small groups enable delegates to benefit from a high level of interaction with peers and trainers alike, and content informed by CIH's policy and practice expertise ensures they leave with a greater understanding of current housing issues.
