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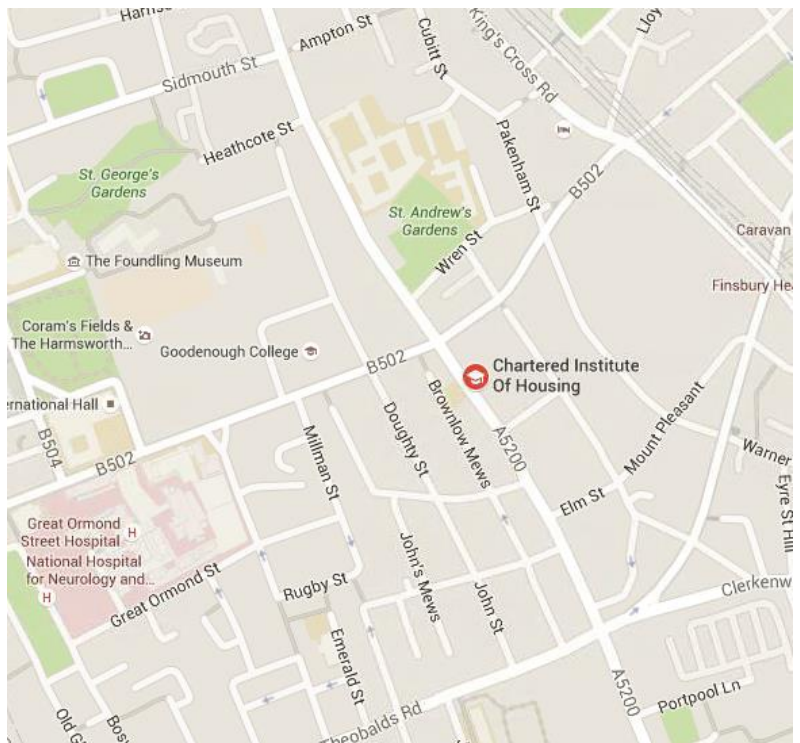

By taxi

There are also plenty of licenced taxis on the main road and a taxi rank outside the ITN building next to the venue.

By bus

The number 17, 45, 46 (Guildford Street stop) bus stop is outside the Institute's offices on Gray's Inn Road, also stopping at King's Cross Station. Other buses stopping in the area include: 4, 19, 38, and 34.

Car parking

The nearest NCP car park is around 500 metres away. It is located at 1 Bowling Green Lane, EC1R 0BD.

By train

London St Pancras and London Euston station are the nearest mainline train stations to Gray's Inn Road.

Russell Square, Piccadilly Line, is the nearest tube station and is an 8 minute walk from the venue.

King's Cross Station is approximately 12 minutes away on foot. If walking, depart King's Cross Station and cross over Euston Road and head down Gray's Inn Road. Continue down this road until you see 236 Gray's Inn Road on your left.
