► The number of homicide cases in Scotland has fallen by more than a third in the past 10 years



Since 2012-13, the number of homicide cases has remained relatively stable, with between 59 and 64 cases each year.






Drug-related deaths in Scotland, 2007-2017







ALCOHOL AND VIOLENT CRIME IN SCOTLAND

- A FACTOR IN 46% OF VIOLENT CRIMES IN 2017/8
- VIOLENT CRIME COSTS £727M PER ANNUM
- 42% OF ALL ACCUSED OF HOMICIDE SINCE 2008 WERE UNDER THE INFLUENCE AT THE TIME






Drug-related hospital patient rates by national deprivation quintile (Scotland; Any hospital type; Any diagnosis)






Challenges: (i) Rising Inequality

- Causal link between rising inequality and increases in violence (see Blau & Blau, 1982; Wilson & Daly, 1997; Wilkinson & Pickett, 2010; Pemberton, 2015)
- Inequality promotes sense of inferiority, status competition, anxiety and lower levels of trust, disrupts community cohesion, that act as driver of violence


Figure 4.1: Intentional killing/inequality


- Effective services must be <u>designed with and for</u> <u>people and communities – not delivered 'top</u> <u>down'</u> for administrative convenience

- <u>Driving continuous reform across all public services</u> based on outcomes, improved performance and cost reduction




