Application for CIH Membership Recognition



The Chartered Institute of Housing (CIH) is the independent voice for housing and the home of [professional standards](#). CIH is a registered charity and not-for-profit organisation.

All of our work, whether it is giving a voice to housing professionals and lobbying the government to change housing policy, training housing professionals through our regulated qualifications and validated programmes or bringing them together at events up and down the country, is dedicated to that mission. Applying for CIH Membership Recognition

In order to promote professional development across the housing industry, CIH can formally recognise regulated qualifications from other Awarding Organisations as eligible for CIH membership.

Applicants requesting recognition of a regulated qualification for CIH membership at CIH Certified Practitioner and CIH Chartered Member grades must complete the application form attached and agree to comply with the following conditions:

1. The regulated qualifications from other Awarding Organisations as eligible for CIH membership must be comparable to [CIH Level 4](#) and [CIH Level 5](#) housing qualifications in terms of:

- Academic level at Level 4 (for CIH Certified Practitioner membership) or Level 5 (for CIH Chartered membership)
- A housing management focus with breadth and depth of housing management content
- Assessment approach and level of rigour

2. If the qualification is recognized by CIH for membership at Certified Practitioner or Chartered Member grades the following terms apply:

- Qualification approval and quality assurance will remain the responsibility of the development/delivery organisation.
- Consideration/recognition of a qualification cannot be deemed as being a formal accreditation or qualification approval, nor should the recognition be promoted in this way.

- A subsequent review to take place after 3 years of the initial recognition, or if the regulated qualification changes (whichever is soonest), subject to a fee.
- The right to use the CIH logo only applies to the approved qualification and cannot be transferred to another organisation or used in connection with another qualification without prior permission from CIH.
- The use of the CIH logo must be in line with CIH brand guidelines provided to ensure that it is used in a consistent and appropriate style.
- CIH retains the right to withdraw recognition if standards are no longer met.

3. Appeals

Where an application is unsuccessful, organisations can appeal against a decision by writing to the Professional Standards inbox (ProfessionalStandards@cih.org) within 28 days of the outcome of an application being received, including details for the appeal, new evidence not provided before or any other relevant information.

Suitable for:

- Housing officers
- Middle management
- Individuals with a CIH recognised qualification at level 3 or 4.

➤ **CIH Chartered Member grade (CIHCM):**

Chartered membership is the hallmark of a member's success in housing; it's a demonstration of housing expertise, and commitment to the highest professional and ethical standards.

Suitable for:

- Senior managers
- Experienced professionals with an aspiration for leadership
- Individuals with a CIH recognised qualification at level 5 or above.

Fees and invoicing

Fees apply for:

- A first application made for qualification(s) recognition
- A subsequent review to take place after 3 years of the initial recognition, or if the regulated qualification changes (whichever is soonest)

CIH recognition fees (from 1 April 2026):

- **Administrative fee for first consideration of application - £200.00+VAT**
- **Subsequent review and continuation of recognition - £100.00 + VAT**

The fees cover:

- The consideration of the application by CIH Professional Standards
- The use of the CIH logo for programme promotion and publicity
- Inclusion of information on the CIH website
- Administration of the recognition process

Invoices will be issued within 10 working days on:

- Receipt of an application for programme recognition
- Please provide purchase order details with your application if required by your organisation.



Guidance for application

Criteria for application for Level 4 and Level 5 qualifications

Please ensure that the qualification:

- Is a regulated qualification (Ofqual or equivalent)
- Clearly aligns with [CIH Level 4](#) or [CIH Level 5](#) housing qualifications
- Has substantive housing management content
- Has evidence of applied assessment (not solely knowledge based/multiple choice)

It is expected that additional documents/evidence will be included in support of your application. Please include a link to the qualification specification on your website.

Evidence should include:

- Details of the syllabus content for the qualification
- Details of the qualification size/number of learners
- Details of assessment methods

For Level 5 qualification applications (for CIH Chartered membership) then please also provide a statement on how the qualification supports the following:

- Understanding what professionalism means in a housing context
- Understanding professional practice & professional standards
- Understanding the importance of reflective practice in a housing context
- Understanding the importance and management of CPD

Once an application has been submitted, CIH Professional Standards will:

- Invoice for the administration fee
- Conduct a review of the application
- Inform the applicant of the outcome decision (feedback will be provided if an application is unsuccessful)
- Inform CIH membership of the decision if qualification approved
- Contact the organisation for a review process at the appropriate time

Please note that formal confirmation of the recognition and the designated logos will be provided when recognition has been approved and the corresponding fee has been paid.
