## What is the Level 2 Certificate in Housing Practice?

The [Level 2 Certificate in Housing Practice](#) provides a general introduction to the housing sector. It has four units:

- ❑ Housing provision and housing organisations
- ❑ Customer service for housing
- ❑ Assets, repairs and maintenance
- ❑ Professional development in housing

## Why study this qualification?

Gaining a qualification is a great way to develop your career prospects. This qualification will give you a basic understanding of housing and introduce you to some of the skills and knowledge necessary to participate in housing related activities.

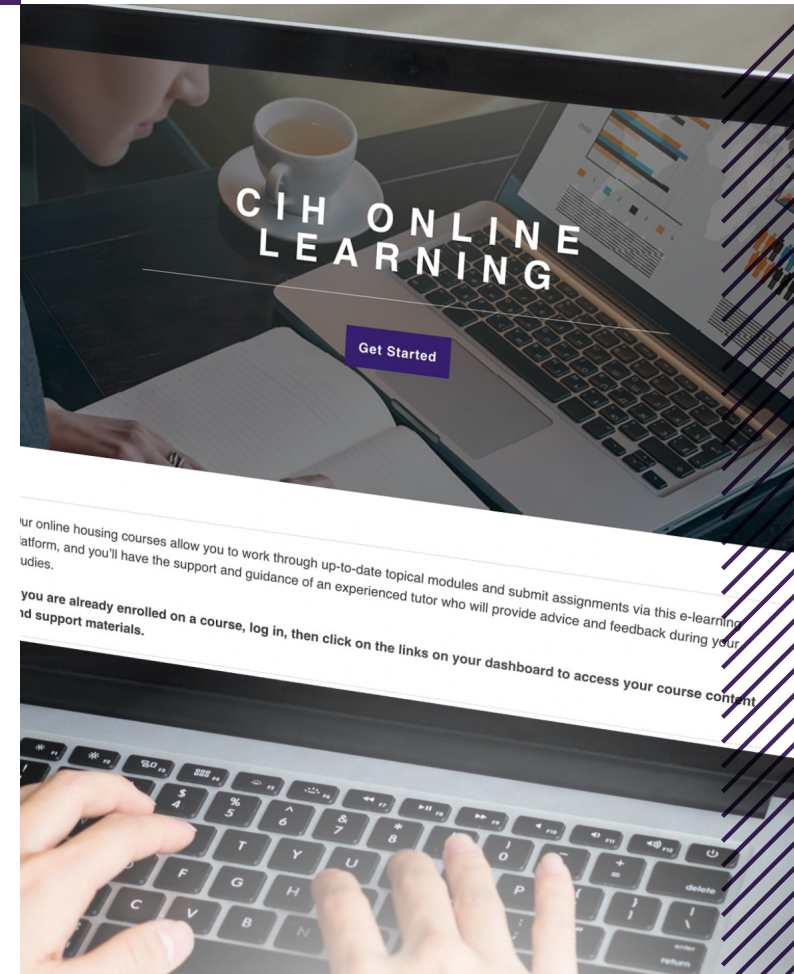
Successful completion of this qualification will prepare you for the [Level 3 Certificate in Housing Practice](#), which CIH also offers online.

## Who should apply for this qualification?

This qualification is suitable for anyone new to housing or working in a frontline position who wants to improve their general awareness of housing or obtain an initial qualification and includes:

- ❑ People who are new to housing or work in a frontline position who want to improve their general awareness of housing
- ❑ People working in housing who wish to gain an initial qualification
- ❑ People not currently working in housing but considering a frontline housing position as a career option
- ❑ Tenants, residents and board members wishing to enhance their personal involvement and understanding of housing.

Applicants must be aged 18 or over, should be confident using IT and have access to a computer. A basic level of literacy is also recommended to complete online tasks.



**Duration:** Approximately 16 weeks, with an average of six-eight hours study a week.

### Housing provision and housing organisations

- ❑ Know how housing organisations are regulated and funded

### Customer service for housing

- ❑ Understand the principles of customer service
- ❑ Know the diverse range and needs of housing customers
- ❑ Understand the principles of equality and diversity

### Assets, repairs and maintenance

- ❑ Know the main types of dwellings across the housing stock
- ❑ Understand the concept of asset management for housing organisations
- ❑ Understand the process for managing repairs and maintenance of housing stock

### Professional development in housing

- ❑ Know about paid and voluntary roles in the housing sector
- ❑ Understand the knowledge, skills and behaviours required to work within the housing sector
- ❑ Be able to plan personal professional development





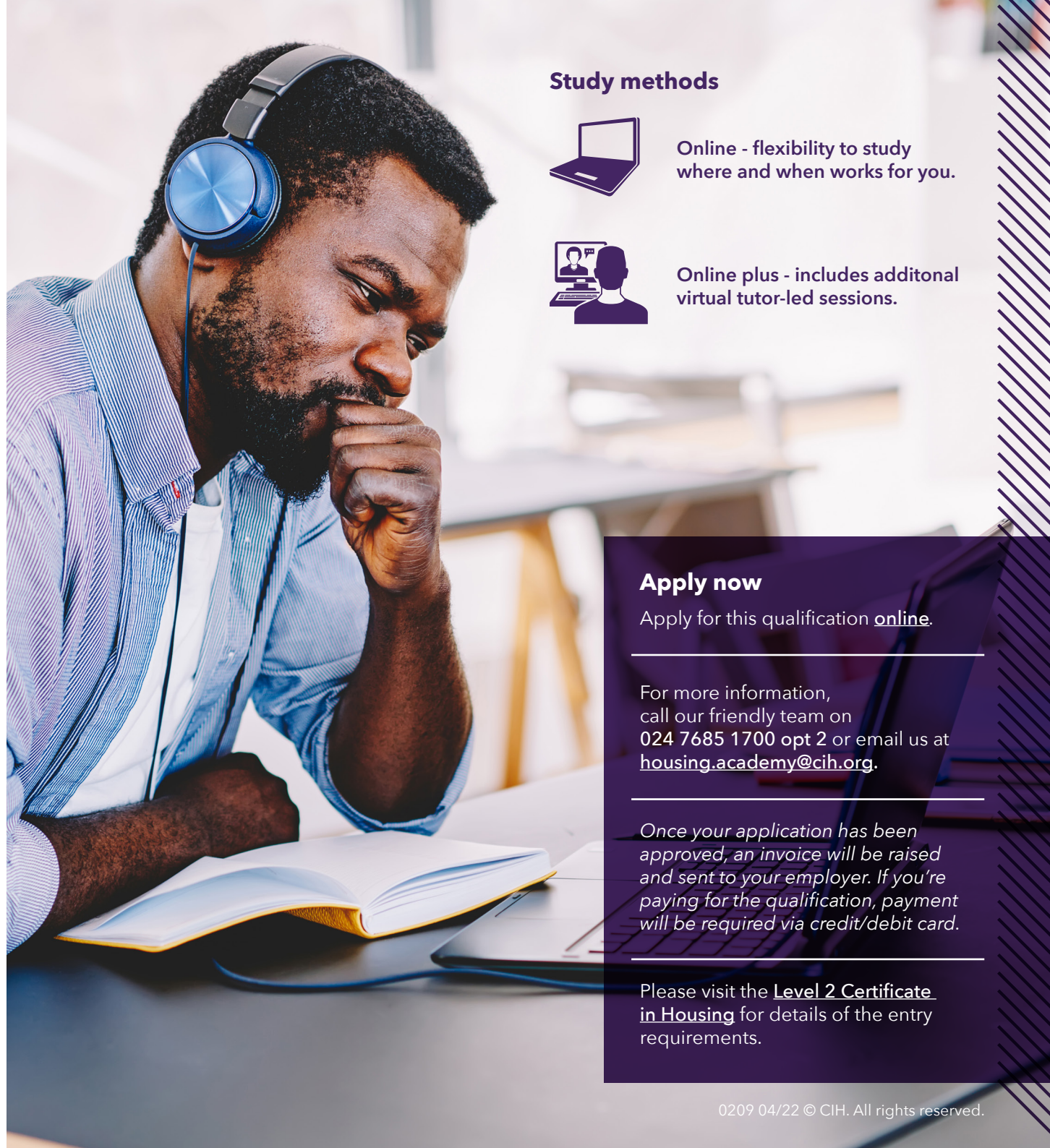
## What can I expect as a CIH online learner?
