Share a bit of information about your group

rour feedback is completely anonymous, but to give us an idea of the range of views from the individuals in your session, we'd value a short outline of who joined your group. This could simply be the number of participants in your discussion; an indication of their age range; how many were members and/or non-members; and their current career level. This will help us to understand how feedback differs across a variety of demographics.
